Mark's abbreviated order of events moves from the temptation to this statement:




What happens in the Galilee area?

- Luke 4:16-21 (cf. Isa 61:1-2; cp Lev 25:10)
- Luke 8:<u>26-33</u> The confrontation with Legion ("opposite Galilee")
- Luke 9:1-6 sends out the 12
- Luke 10:<u>1-12</u> sends out 70/72
- Return of those disciples (Luke 10:17-20)


Matt 15:29 Jesus went on from there and walked beside the Sea of Galilee. . .


Matt 16:13 Now when Jesus came into the district of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?"











Caesarea Philippi / Banias / Panias

- O Mark 8:27-30 (Matt 16:13-16; Lk 9:18-20)
  - O Peter's Confession ("And Jesus went on with his disciples to the villages of Caesarea Philippi")

- O You are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not be able to stand <u>against</u> it.
  - o "against" not in original text (just verb + object)

- o"And after six days Jesus took with him Peter and James and John, and led them up a high mountain"
- O Mount Hermon best candidate (right there)

# Jesus & Cosmic Geography Transfiguration Location

- In early church tradition, the location of the mount of transfiguration was believed by many to be Mount Tabor.
- The earliest witness to Tabor = 4<sup>th</sup> century A.D.
- The gospels themselves give no name, and so the tradition has no biblical precedent.

Mount Hermon is considered by many the better choice since it is much higher than Tabor (8,500 feet vs. 1,843 feet), which would fit better with the description of a "high mountain" by Mark (and in Matthew 17:1).

#### **Transfiguration Event**

- O Elijah (forerunner; type / anti-type John);
- O Moses (Deut 18:15-19; type)

"... symbolize the coming of the messianic age, and their conversation with Jesus marks him out the more clearly as the Messiah who comes as the climax to their eschatological role." (France, *The Gospel of Matthew*, 648)

#### **More connections:**

- oMoses and Elijah went up on Mount Sinai to meet with God; both saw his glory (Exod 24:15–18; 33:18–23; 1 Kgs 19:8–13).
- OBoth men also suffered rejection and hostility from the people to whom they were sent, and so prefigured the experience of Jesus the Messiah. (France, 648)

#### Don't Miss the Point

o The stories of the gospels presume the spiritual warfare / cosmicgeographical worldview of the Old Testament.

# SPIRITUAL WARFARE

PRESENT: The ministry of the Spirit, the Church as sacred space, the nullification of the authority of the OT gods, the Great Commission.

The New Testament links the resurrection & ascension with the sending of the Spirit (who is but isn't Jesus) and the nullification of the authority of the gods of the nations (Deuteronomy 32 worldview).

# Jesus and the Spirit

John 14:26 - But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.

# Jesus and the Spirit

John 15:26 - But when the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, he will bear witness about me.

# Jesus and the Spirit

John 16:7-8 - Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you. And when he comes, he will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment:




Psalms → Book Three → Psalm 78

# Two (& Three) Powers: OT - NT

HS = "Spirit of Jesus"

(Phil 1:19)

Rom 8:9

Spirit of God = "Spirit of Christ" (1 Pet 1:11)

**Gal 4:6** – God sent "Spirit of his Son" into our hearts

- "rulers" (archontōn | archōn, archē)
- "principalities" (αrchē)
- o "authorities" (exousiα)
- "powers" (dynamis)
- o "dominions" / "lords" (kyrios)
- o "thrones" (thronos)

None of the <u>rulers</u> of this age understood this, for if they had, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory. (1 Cor 2:8)

The death, burial, resurrection, and ascension of Jesus not only was the cure for the first primeval rebellion, it was the antidote to the second and third rebellions – human depravity, fragmentation of the nations enslaved to the dark powers.







# **Paul - Cosmic Geography**

o Rom 15:20 and thus I make it my ambition to preach the gospel, not where Christ has already been named, lest I build on someone else's foundation . . . 23 But now, since I no longer have any room for work in these regions, and since I have longed for many years to come to you, 24 I hope to see you in passing as I go to Spain . . . 28 When therefore I have completed this and have delivered to them what has been collected, I will leave for Spain by way of you.

# **New Testament Sacred Space**

FUTURE: The fullness of the Gentiles, glorified children of God, inheriting the nations

# Already, but Not Yet

Believers are sons and daughters of God . . . But await their full glorification and inheritance.

- o Edenic Vision Restored
- Divine Council Reconstituted

Jesus's death and resurrection makes it possible for us to be reconciled to God and conquer the inevitable death that results from the failure in Eden.

O Addresses Rebellion #1

Jesus's resurrection and ascension was the necessary precursor and catalyst for the coming of the Spirit, who now indwells believers, empowering them to resist sin and be what God intended.

O Addresses Rebellion #2

Jesus's resurrection and ascension means the kingdom of God that was offered has been inaugurated. That kingdom must include people from all nations to reverse Babel and restore Eden.

Addresses Rebellion #3

Children of God; restored human family of God:

- O John 1:12
- o 1 John 3:1-3
- o Rom 8:14-15
- o Heb 2:10-13

Residents of God's kingdom, inheritors of the promises given to Abraham.

The new, "circumcision neutral" children of Abraham.

Children of God, fit for sacred space because we are *in Christ*.

The nature of our inheritance. . . .

Revelation 2 [Jesus says]:

<sup>25</sup> Nevertheless, hold fast to what you have until I come. <sup>26</sup> And the one who conquers and who keeps my works until the end, I will give him authority over the nations, <sup>27</sup> and "he will shepherd them with an iron rod; he will break *them* in pieces like jars made of clay," <sup>28</sup> as I also have received from my Father, and I will give him the morning star.

The morning star language in Rev. 2:28 is messianic—it refers to a divine being who would come from Judah.

We know this by considering two other passages in tandem.

o In Num. 24:17, we read the prophecy that "a star will go out from Jacob, and a scepter will rise from Israel."

Later in the book of Revelation, Jesus himself refers to his messianic standing with the morning star language:


"I am the root and the descendant of David, the bright morning star" (Rev. 22:16).

Revelation 3 [Jesus says]:

<sup>20</sup> Behold, I stand at the door and knock! If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, indeed I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with me. <sup>21</sup> The one who conquers, I will grant to him to sit down with me on my throne, as I also have conquered and have sat down with my Father on his throne.
